We appreciate the commitment you, as parents have in bringing your children to choir. Your directors are committed volunteers, and are asking for your help in any way you feel called.

1. **Volunteer** as much as you can. If you haven't filled out the volunteer form, it's never too late! Each director may also have sign-up sheets at rehearsal.
2. Our first rehearsal is September 7.
3. **All choirs start** at 6:15 and end at 7:15. Please be timely in dropping off and picking up your children. Those remaining in the choir room at 7:20 will be taken to child care.
 - a. Please let directors know **in writing** if your children are permitted to leave the choir room to meet you elsewhere at the end of rehearsal.
 - b. Please let us know of any unusual circumstance regarding people who may be picking up your children following rehearsal.
4. **Attendance is important!** The directors work on anthems for at least six weeks in advance. Your child cannot expect to miss four weeks and show up on Sunday to sing. He or she will not know the song or the procedure involved. Not only is this difficult for your child, it diminishes the quality of the worship experience for the remainder of the children.
5. If your child will be **absent**, please call the director.
6. **Please write** down important dates on your calendar.
