

Youth Safety Policy

How exciting! We are finally in the new youth facility, the Lighthouse! Our first week of Wednesday Night Bible Study, Sunday School and UMYF went GREAT! In this transition period we do need all the parents' and youths' assistance with some logistical items:

- According to Bethany's child, youth and adult safety policy, all youth must sign in. There will be sign in sheets in the choir room and in the Lighthouse Assembly Room. Youth please sign in when you arrive. The sign in sheet from the choir room will be brought to the Lighthouse following choir.
- All senior high youth must sign themselves out in the Lighthouse Assembly Room and be picked up from the Lighthouse Assembly Room. This means everyone. Even if you are only going to part of the evenings' programs (i.e. choir, youth worship, etc.), you will leave via the Lighthouse Assembly Room. This is for the youths' safety and also to assist the sponsors in keeping track of the youth for whom they are accountable.
- For their safety, all middle school youth must be signed out by a parent or an adult they are carpooling with. This adult must come in and sign them out. Notes from parents cannot be accepted.
- All youth, regardless of which programs they are attending, must be picked up at the entrance to the Lighthouse Assembly Room. This is by the Ark (covered drop off point in the back parking lot.)
- All youth who come to the campus need to be involved in the programs they are here to attend and not wandering around. There is no supervision on Sundays until 4 p.m. when Fellowship starts, with the exception of Pure Sound Praise Band and JuBellation Ringers, which starts at 3 p.m. If youth arrive before 4:00 they need to be in Praise Band or JuBellation Ringers.
